

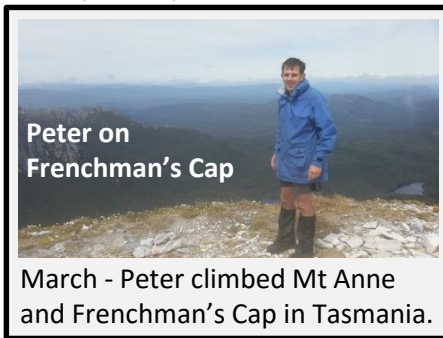
Merry Christmas 2015 and a Happy New Year!

Highlights from the year in pictures...



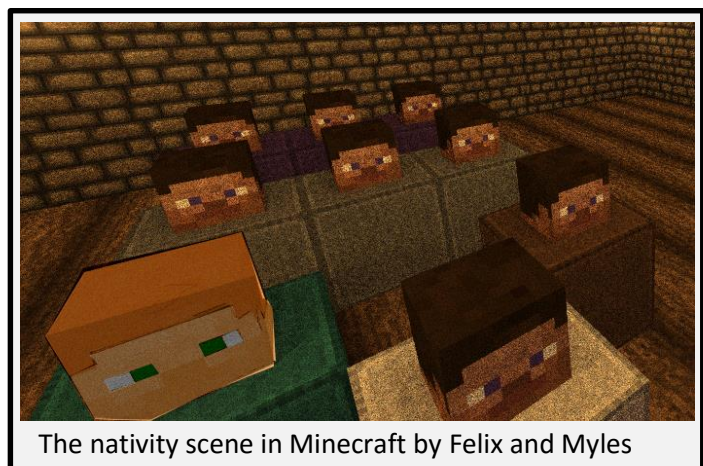
